

## First launch: two questions asked once, never again

### What are you scoring?

Tap your sport — you can change it anytime.

Soccer

Basketball

Football

Baseball

Volleyball

Wrestling

### Where should the score show?

Pick one — there's nothing else to set up.

LED scoreboard  
A real LED board at the field or gym

TV or projector  
AirPlay, casting, or an HDMI cable

Just this phone or iPad  
Prop it up — the screen becomes the board

### That's the setup.

The app remembers both answers and opens straight into scoring every time after. Change either one whenever you like from the top bar — there is no settings menu to hunt through.

Now connect the screen you picked, using the matching column below. You only ever do **one** of these, and the scoreboard appears on its own once the screen is connected — nothing to pair, no IP address to type, and no app to install on the TV.

1. Tap your sport.

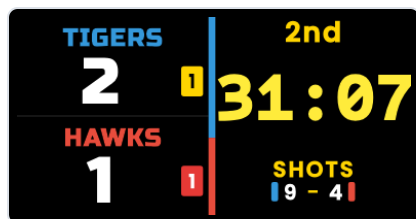
2. Tap where the score should show.

## Connect the screen choose one

### LED SCOREBOARD

Wired — field or gym board

- 1 Connect your phone or iPad to the board's **video processor box** with an HDMI adapter.
- 2 The scoreboard **lights up on the board by itself** — there is no button to press.
- 3 Keep scoring on your device. The board follows every tap instantly.

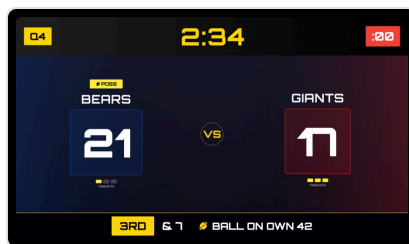


Your board will look like this. Soccer on a 384×192 panel. 288×144 and 320×160 are built in too.

### TV OR PROJECTOR

Wireless — AirPlay or Cast

- 1 **iPhone / iPad:** swipe down from the top-right corner → **Screen Mirroring** → pick the TV.  
**Android:** swipe down → **Cast** or **Smart View** → pick the TV.
- 2 The scoreboard **fills the TV by itself**.
- 3 Keep scoring on your device.

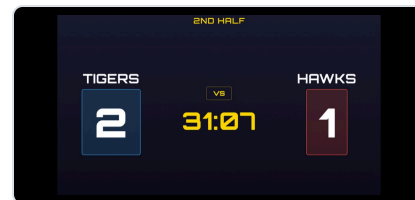


Your TV will look like this. The layout scales itself from 720p to 4K, ultrawide and 4:3.

### NO BOARD AT ALL

The device is the scoreboard

- 1 Tap the **board icon** in the top bar of the scoring screen.
- 2 The screen becomes the full scoreboard — **prop it up** on the scorer's table.
- 3 Tap the screen, then **Back to scoring**, to return.



Your screen will look like this. Same layout the big boards get, sized to the device.

## Good to know

### The board went black mid-game.

It comes back on its own — DisplayScore re-sends the scoreboard after a cable glitch or a panel sleeping, and keeps the screen awake all game.

### Does my phone just mirror the board?

No. The board shows the scoreboard while your device keeps showing the controls — two different screens, one game.

### Which HDMI adapter do I need?

Any powered adapter for your device: Lightning or USB-C Digital AV for iPhone and iPad, USB-C to HDMI for Android.

### The board looks stretched or cropped.

Pick your panel size from the resolution menu. Presets cover the common LED panels and every standard TV resolution.

### Can I put the score on a stream?

Tap **Go Live** on the clock card. You get a link to paste into OBS or vMix as a browser source, and the animated score bug follows the game by itself.

### Wrong team on the left?

Team names and colors are set on the scoring screen and update the board live — no need to restart the game.

## NO EXTRAS REQUIRED

Everything above happens inside the app. There is no separate configuration tool, no account needed to score a game, and no network at all for a wired board.

Keep this sheet with the board. Setup takes under a minute.
